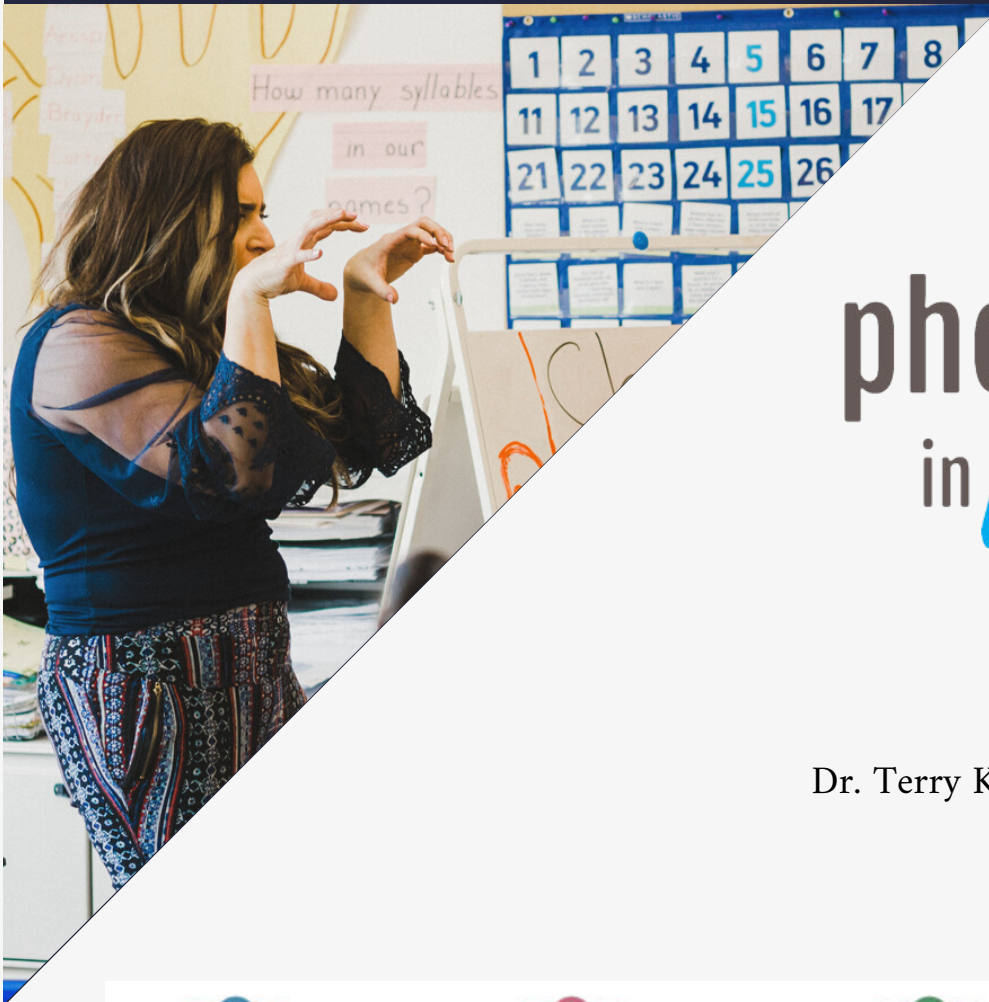

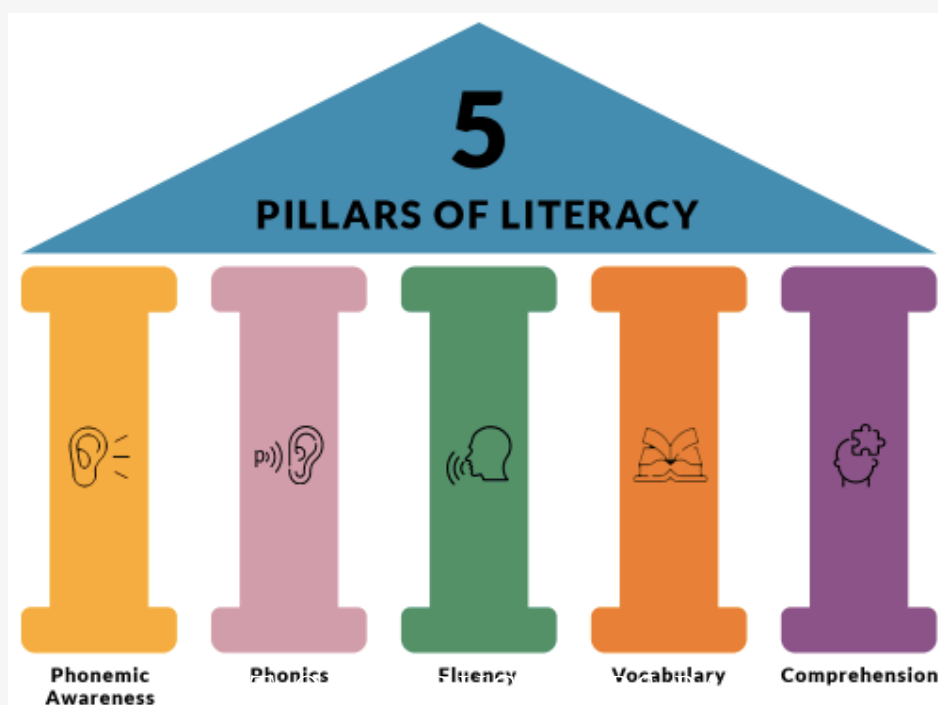

Kinesthetic Motions for the Phonemes

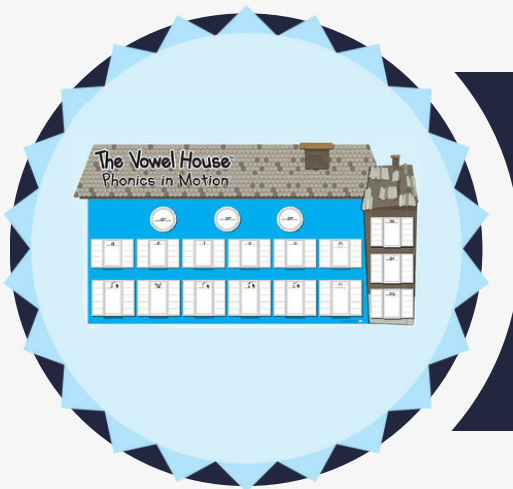
Set your students up for success by engaging them in language exploration with the Kinesthetic Motions for Phonemes (KMPs)!
